Basic Painting Supplies

- 4 to 6 stretched, primed canvases of varying size (rectangular)
- 1 or 2 primed canvas boards (used optionally, in place of some of the above stretched canvases)
- Assortment of **white hog's hair brushes, rounds or filberts** – sizes #2, #4, #8, #10
- Palette - glass is best (from hardware or recycle) or purchased wood palette or palette pad - no smaller than 12"x16" (the larger the better)
- Gamsol odorless thinner (small container);
- 2 glass jars (with lids!)
- 1 to 2 Palette knives (with neck) about 2" long (metal recommended, plastic is available)
- Small bottle of refined linseed oil
- Cotton rags or paper towels
- Pencil with 2B or 4B lead
- 1 roll of masking tape

Basic paint colors (oil or acrylic)

- **Titanium white**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Cadmium yellow light**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Cadmium red light**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Ultramarine blue**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Alizarin crimson**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)

Optional paint colors recommended for curiosity & enhancement of color palette (in order of importance):

- **Ivory black**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Yellow Ochre**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Burnt Umber**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Cerulean blue**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Burnt Sienna or Venetian Red**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Quinacridone Rose, or Rose Madder**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)
- **Sap green**, small tube (1.25 us fl. oz.)

Extra Supplies to Use in Class

- Drawing paper or sketch pad
- Charcoal sticks
- Ruler
- Coil jar for brush cleaning
- Thin Latex Gloves (1 box)
- Old Work Clothes, or Apron

IF YOU ARE USING ACRYLIC PAINT INSTEAD OF THE ABOVE LISTED OILS, MAKE SURE YOU FIND THE EQUIVALENT COLORS AND MAKE SURE YOUR BRUSHES ARE LABELED FOR ACRYLIC. WHILE BEING USED, BRUSHES FOR ACRYLIC PAINT NEED TO BE KEPT IN WATER. LINSEED OIL IS NOT FOR ACRYLIC PAINT – INSTEAD ONE COULD USE MATTE OR GLOSS ACRYLIC MEDIUM THAT COMES IN A JAR OR TUBE.
