Workshop: Solving the Color Puzzle

Supply List:

- 1 Large sheet of watercolor paper (22x30) or 2 sheets of 18x24 (90lb or more)
- Favorite selection of acrylic or oil colors (what you use most frequently and colors you gravitate towards)
- Mandatory colors (in oil or acrylic): Naples Yellow, Titanium White, Prussian Blue, Burnt Umber
- Color swatches from the hardware store paint section: Pick colors with the purpose of selecting 1. what you gravitate towards, 2. colors that are memory triggers
- a flat brush (#6 or 8 acrylic/oil brush)
- Palette knife
- Disposable palette book (you will need a few sheets)
- a board that supports your paper
- masking tape
- pre-gesso paper if you are going to use oil paint with 2 coats of gesso per sheet
- paper towels
- if using acrylic, retarder medium is recommended.
- pencil/notebooks for note-taking
