

## The Figure in Space

This workshop will enable students to situate the figure in meaningful space. Students will learn of the importance of the space that surrounds the figure and will learn how to embed the figure in a composition that does not distinguish between figure/background. Spatial considerations will include color and image construction from life and from photographs.

Students will work from life with a model over the 4 days.

Expect to be working with mixed media and house paints, on large drawing paper.

Please bring:

- Charcoal, both vine and compressed
- Pastels
- Colored Pencils
- Acrylic brushes - suggested sizes: #8, #10, #12, & 2"
- Glue - plain Elmer's glue is great
- Disposable palettes
- Scissors (for collage elements)
- You may want to bring a smock and gloves
