General Supplies:

- Smooth Drawing board (23 1/2" x 26")—Please note the drawing boards at the school are very rough in texture. I recommend bringing a smooth surface.
- Sketchbook (8 1/2" x 11" or larger)
- Graphite pencils (7H, 6H, 5H, 4H, 2H, H, 2B, 3B, 4B, 5B, 6B, 8B)
- Ruler or other straight-edge
- Soft cloth for blending (wool sweater, etc.)
- Staedler/Mars White vinyl eraser, kneaded eraser, or gum eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- Piece of fine-tooth sandpaper
- Artist, draftsman, or blue painters' tape (optional)
- Clips or clamps for attaching paper to the board
